Upcoming events include the return of the Gong Show on September 10th. If you have a talent to share, please sign up and entertain us. Good or


bad, it's bound to be a night of hilarious acts and laughter!





Naturally, the Air Force birthday owes a great deal to Orville and Wilbur Wright who pioneered mechanized flight with their successful mission in 1903.
