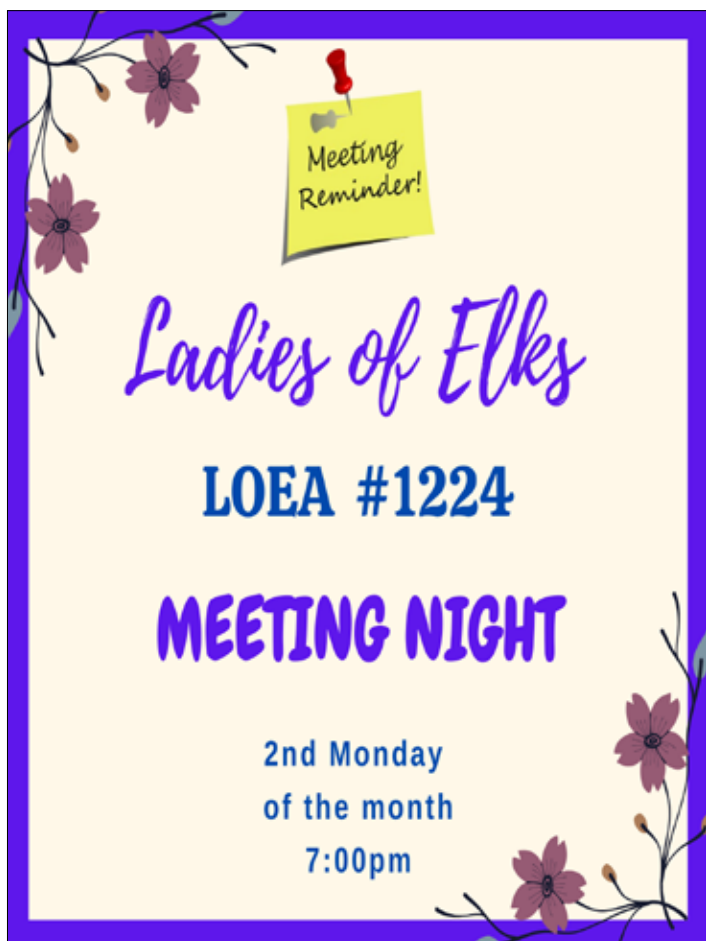
bring your dollars and play along with us. It's sure to be a great evening with chances to win stuff!

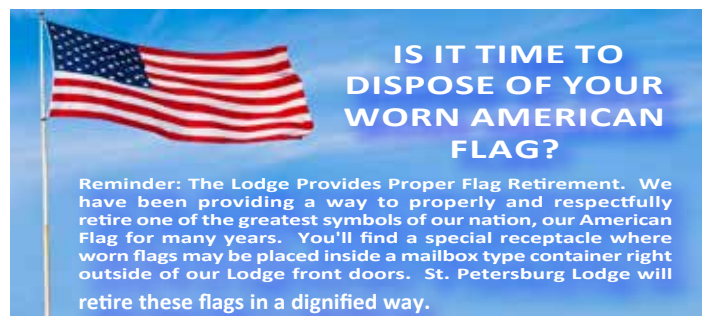

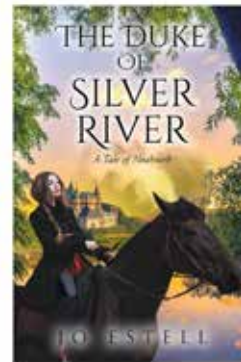
