

unteers, and I'd like to give a heartfelt thank you to everyone who supports and participates in our events.


Coming up this month we have the Country Western Night on January 14th. Tickets are \$10 and available now at the bar. It's sure to be a boot-scootin' great time!

The Lodge is seeking to fill the Officer position of SECRETARY. The current Secretary, Toni, is stepping down after 13 years and the Lodge is seeking her replacement.

The candidate for Secretary has to be an Elk or be willing to be an Elk, have a strong understanding of accounting, be organized, motivated and have good people skills.

Nominations for Secretary are being taken again, starting December 1, 2022, until the position is filled.
