As of January 17th all veterans can access emergency mental care free of charge at any Department of veterans affairs or non-VA health care facility, regardless of whether you are enrolled in the VA health care system. This new policy applies to all veterans with any separation status except a dishonorable discharge. This is regardless of whether you qualify for othe VA medical services.

This is great news but I am still a believer that all veterans should call 3986661 press 0 and ask the operator for eligibility.

JUNE OBSERVANCES

D-Day June 6th Observance

On June 6, 1944, Allied soldiers bravely stormed the beaches of Normandy, France. The Normandy beaches were chosen because of the range of air cover, and it was the shortest distance from Great Britain. Five landing beaches were selected for the assault: Utah, Omaha, Gold, Juno, and Sword. As dawn broke, the largest armada assembled began its assault on the beaches of Normandy. By the end of the day, the Atlantic Wall, (which took the Germans years to build), had fallen and the invasion was a success. The events of D-Day forged partnerships and reinforced trans-Atlantic bonds that remain strong today. D-Day will be commemorated on Tuesday, June 6, 2023, the 79th anniversary of D-Day also known as the Allied Invasion of Normandy.

Flag Day 2023

Flag Day is celebrated by Americans on June 14 each year and commemorates the adoption of the Stars and Stripes as the official flag of the United States. Many Americans celebrate Flag Day by displaying the Red, White and Blue in front of homes and businesses. Some communities, schools and veterans' organizations hold Flag Day parades, essay contests, ceremonies and picnics. Presidents have also issued proclamations for National Flag Week. Flag Day will be celebrated this year on Wednesday, June 14, 2023. Flag Week is celebrated the week of June 14th, every year.

US Army Birthday

The official birthday of the United States Army is June 14, 1775. It's easy to assume that this date implies the creation of a fully realized standing army, but the truth is that when the first shots were fired in the American Revolution, the troops involved in fighting the British could be compared to a guerrilla force; colonists from a variety of militias in the area banded together to fight the "Redcoats."

The U.S. Army operates with close to half a million active-duty soldiers. The service has come a long way since it was created approximately a year prior to the signing of the Declaration of Independence.

Coast Guard Auxiliary Birthday

The U.S. Armed Forces are made up of Active Duty components supplemented by Reserve forces such as the Army Reserve, Air Force Reserve, etc., but a non-military and unpaid civilian auxiliary exists for two branches: the Air Force and Coast Guard.


The Coast Guard is considered military service but is not part of the Defense Department, which is an important distinction from its' Army, Navy, Air Force, and Marine Corps counterparts.

The Coast Guard Auxiliary is, as mentioned above, an unpaid force of volunteers who perform duties similar to or in support of the regular Coast Guard. Legislation passed in the mid-1990s authorized the Auxiliary to support any Coast Guard missions not involving law enforcement or real-world military operations. Further legislation realigned the Coast Guard, Reserve, and Auxiliary under the Department of Homeland Security. Prior to that, it was considered part of the U.S. Department of Transportation.

The Coast Guard Auxiliary mission involves many activities that promote and support maritime safety, recreational boating safety, fighting pollution, even rescues. The Coast Guard Auxiliary Birthday will be Friday, June 23, 2023.


