JULY OBSERVANCES

INDEPENDENCE DAY

On July 4th, 1776 the United States laid down its claim to be a free and independent nation by adopting the Declaration of Independence. Today, Independence Day is celebrated and honored in many forms such as fireworks, BBQs and parades. It is an opportunity for Americans to express patriotism and love of country including reflecting on the sacrifices from those in the military. Independence Day will be officially observed on Tuesday, July 4, 2023, our nation's 246th birthday.

NATIONAL HIRE A VETERAN DAY

Roughly 200,000 military members retire or separate from the armed services every year, according to the Department of Labor.

These veterans bring competitive skills to civilian jobs, along with core values military service cultivates: dedication, teamwork, good communication and pride in getting work done. But, finding and competing for civilian positions can be challenging for transitioning veterans.

National Hire A Veteran Day aims to inspire employers to recruit and hire veterans by recognizing the unique skills and values that former soldiers, sailors, airmen, Marines and Coast Guardsmen bring to the workforce.

This day will be officially observed on Tuesday, July 25, 2023

NATIONAL KOREAN WAR VETERANS ARMISTICE DAY

Observed each year on July 27th. It is a time to remember as many as 50,000 American troops who died in the conflict (official sources vary on the actual number), and over 100,000 wounded, and thousands of prisoners of war.

Each year, the President of the United States issues a proclamation announcing July 27th as a day of national observance in honor of Korean War veterans and their families. There are observances of this day on military bases, at military cemeteries such as Arlington National Cemetery, and more informal observances held in America, South Korea, and elsewhere.

The National Korean War Veterans Armistice Day will be observed on Wednesday, July 27th, 2022.

NATIONAL BUFFALO SOLDIERS DAY

This is the holiday celebrating the contributions of some of the earliest African-American troops in the United States military. These troops served on the Western frontier after the Civil War. They served in a variety of ways including security, law enforcement, and other frontier-specific activities. In 1866, Congress passed legislation known as the Army Organization Act, which formalized the creation of six all-Black U.S. Cavalry and infantry units.

National Buffalo Soldiers Day will be celebrated on Friday, July 28, 2023.


ARMY CHAPLAIN CORPS ANNIVERSARY






