

Another motto used was "Three in a row, lets grow" in reference to the overall gain in membership the Elks have had over the past two years.

On Tuesday the delegates passed 14 and rejected 4 resolutions to amend the statutes and Constitution of the Order during the Legislative Session. 

MILITARY OBSERVANCES

ANTITERRORISM AWARENESS MONTH

August is Antiterrorism Month, which is designed to raise awareness not only of the threat of terrorism, but also to encourage regular vigilance and communication to report potential threats. Throughout the month there is a series of articles highlighting key points for increased awareness of goals, objectives and measures.

Training seminars and videos are also part of this family-oriented outreach. Some videos are available from individual Army commands via YouTube.

COAST GUARD DAY

Coast Guard Day is held each year on Aug. 4th to recognize and honor the efforts of The United States Coast Guard. This celebration is considered an "internal" event for active and reserve Coast Guard members, plus their civilian employees and retirees and members of the Coast Guard Auxiliary. Coast Guard Day will be celebrated on Friday, Aug. 4, 2023.

NATIONAL PURPLE HEART DAY

Purple Heart Day is observed on Aug. 7 each year and is a time for Americans to remember and honor the brave men and women who were either wounded on the battlefield or paid the ultimate sacrifice with their lives. Purple Heart Day is also known as National Purple Heart Day, Purple Heart Recognition Day, and Purple Heart Appreciation Day. Purple Heart Day will be observed on Monday, Aug. 7, 2023.

AGENT ORANGE AWARENESS DAY

Agent Orange Awareness Day is an annual observation designed to raise awareness of the effects of the herbicide known as Agent Orange, used in Vietnam by American forces to defoliate future and current battlegrounds with the purpose of depriving the enemy ground cover to hide in.

Agent Orange is responsible for a wide range of adverse effects in human beings and the Department of Veterans Affairs lists Agent Orange exposure or potential exposure as a presumptive condition, meaning that those who report exposure and have certain medical conditions are presumed to have those medical issues A) as a result of military service and B) most likely have those conditions due to the exposure. The Next Agent Orange Awareness Day will be observed on Thursday, Aug. 10, 2023.

NATIONAL AIRBORNE DAY


National Airborne Day, observed on Aug. 16th each year, celebrates the accomplishments of Army parachute tradition. The Army's Airborne Rangers and the Army Golden Knights parachute team are among the best-known American paratrooper organizations, and the accomplishments of Army paratroopers are noted across more than seven decades of service including the Iraq war in 2003. National Airborne Day will be observed on Wednesday, Aug. 16, 2023.

MARINE CORPS RESERVE BIRTHDAY

The Marine Forces Reserve (also known as the United States Marine Corps Reserve or the U.S. Marine Corps Forces Reserve) was created in 1916, in conjunction with the creation of the Navy Reserve. Since then, the evolution of this force would expand from just thirty-five to today's roughly 40,000 Marine Corps Reservists. The Marine Corps Reserve Birthday is observed every year on the 29th of August. Marine Corps Reserve birthday will be celebrated on Tuesday, Aug. 29, 2023.these






