The process is simple and it involves submitting a reinstatement application to be read at our Lodge meeting and voted on.



Prayer Chain Requests





COLUMBUS DAY

Columbus Day will be observed on Oct. 14, 2024

Columbus Day is observed in the United States on the second Monday in October. It commemorates Christopher Columbus and his journey to what was then known as the New World.

He arrived in the Americas on Oct. 12, 1492. The holiday has become more controversial in recent decades thanks to the growing awareness of the plight of indigenous peoples. The native people were dramatically affected by Columbus' discovery, the following European migration, and conflicts that arose from that migration.

Christopher Columbus: Not the First European to Set Foot in America. One of the myths of Columbus Day has been that Christopher Columbus was the first European to arrive on what would eventually become American shores. Leif Erikson, an Icelandic Viking, made the journey 500 years prior to Columbus' expedition,

Erickson's feat did not result in the same immigration of Europeans to these shores that Columbus' voyage inspired. This is the primary reason why Christopher Columbus receives the credit that Leif Erikson does not.

Another European explorer named John Cabot was the first non-Viking to set foot in America on written record in 1497. Some sources speculate that the reason Cabot was not given credit in American history books was due to the fact that he sailed for England. Cabot claimed the land for the British crown, which was a controversial point later with the American Revolution.

HAPPY BIRTHDAY TO THE U.S. NAVY

The U.S. Navy will celebrate on Sunday, Oct. 13th, 2024

Some might be surprised to learn that the official birthday of the United States Navy is Oct. 13, 1775. Back then, it was known as the Continental Navy and consisted of a small fleet of ships patrolling to intercept ships sent to resupply British Army troops at or near the colonies.

The creation of this fleet was not without controversy. In fact, it was hotly debated for 11 days in the Continental Congress. According to the official website of the U.S. Navy, some in that debate were convinced that having a standing navy was "the maddest idea in the world."

In the end, the debates were won by "navalists" who were in favor of adding a naval fleet as another branch of defense in addition to the already-created Continental Army which was authorized in June of 1775.

The Navy Birthday: Not To Be Confused With Navy Day

The U.S. Navy birthday should not be confused with Navy Day, which was created in 1922 to recognize the service of all Navy members. Believe it or not, Navy Day pre-dates official recognition of the Navy Birthday. Navy Day is observed on Oct. 27. That date was chosen, so the story goes, in honor of President Teddy Roosevelt whose birthday is also on the 27th.







