

Reflecting on the past year, the Board has done a great job with projects around the lodge. The new floors look amazing, along with the fresh paint. Look forward to other projects this coming year.


The House Committee has done a great job keeping the Calendar full of activities. They have the rest of the Elk year full of fun events.

The process is simple and it involves submitting a reinstatement application to be read at our Lodge meeting and voted on.




Although a reinstatement is gaining back a former member, our Lodge is also gaining a new member!

# Prayer Chain Requests







I read an article in my VFW magazine that I need to bring to the attention of the veterans who have (Other-Than-Honorable Discharges). The VA, in October, announced a new program aimed at helping veterans with this problem to seek upgrades to their discharge status. This program provides funds to the service organizations that assist veterans with applying for VA benefits. It would be worth your while to try to get your eligibility to the VA Changed.

The VFW has an office in the Dept of veterans affairs office on the Bay Pines campus. Jason Smith should be your contact and the phone number is 727-319-7483. Over 57,000 individuals have been granted to eligibility thru this program. Things happen while we are serving our country and everyone's case is different. This itself may help to turn a veterans life around





